

### **IMI VERIFICATION SERVICES:**

IMI will conduct a Source and Age audit to determine if Producer's identified Calving Group(s) meet the USDA's Process Verified Standard, as such standard may be amended from time to time. IMI will conduct an off-site records review and phone audit to determine compliance. If verified, Producer will receive a certificate of approval and will be listed on IMI's Approved Supplier List identifying specific claims which have been verified for Producer. The USDA Process Verified Program requires an onsite review of a small percentage of offsite verifications conducted on an annual basis. As a result, all source verifications are subject to a random onsite review.
