Ambassador Application

The AGJA Ambassador Program encourages youth involvement in the breed's activities. The young men and women who serve as the Ambassador represent the AGJA at Gelbvieh functions throughout the year at the local, state, regional and national level.

Eligibility:

AGJA Members interested in working for the future of the Gelbvieh breed and improving their own leadership skills are encouraged to apply to serve as the official AGJA Ambassador.

- 1. Candidates must be 8 but not yet reached their 20th birthday by January 1, 2022.
- 2. Candidates must complete the official AGJA Ambassador's Application and submit it to the AGA office, postmarked by June 1, 2022.

Candidate Requirements:

- 1. Applicants will complete an informal and brief interview during Opening Ceremonies on Sunday, July 3, 2022 following the AGJA Board of Director Interviews.
- 2. Each applicant must be prepared to give a 2-5-minute speech during the AGJA Annual Meeting on Wednesday, July 6, 2022 following the AGJA Board of Director speeches.
- 3. Requirements are based on the elected candidate's age.
 - a. Please review the attached document for a full list of requirements as it pertains to your age division.
- 4. Applicant must submit a typed essay of 300-500 words or less describing why you would like to serve as the offical AGJA Ambassador for the upcoming year.
- 5. Applicant must provide three references along with appropriate contact information.
 - a. Examples: Teacher, Advisor, Cooperative Extension Agent/FFA Advisor
- 6. Applicant will provide a recent photo; may be attached to the cover sheet of application.
- 7. Applicant must sign the attached **Ambassdor Responsibilities**.
