## 1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$35.00 per head. Free parking included with entry.
- C. Heifers are eligible to show in the Open show as well. Entry must be made for both shows.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

## 2. Special Rules:

- A. Females in this division must be at least 75% Gelbvieh and registered with the American Gelbvieh Association. Gelbvieh females 75% to 100% will show together within their respective age group. Original registration certificates on each animal must be available for inspection at the show. Any animal not having a legible tattoo or EID which matches the registration certificate will be barred from the show.
- B. Colorado Gelbvieh Association will pay one-half of the premiums offered (\$500.00). The National Western Stock Show will pay one-half of the premiums offered (\$500.00) and all premiums will be paid directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
- C. The junior exhibitor who entered the show must be present to show.
- D. Balancers: To qualify for the Balancer Show all cattle must meet the American Gelbvieh Association rules for registration as a Balancer hybrid and will show together in their respective age group.
- E. Note: Gelbvieh females that are 75% that qualify to show in either the Gelbvieh or Balancer Junior Show, can only be entered and exhibited in one show. Exhibitors must designate Gelbvieh (GV) or Balancer (BA), as Breed on entry form - no changes will be allowed after the entries are received.

## 1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$70.00 per head, and a \$25.00 per head pre-bedding fee will be added. Free parking is included with entry.
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at [store.nationalwestern.com](http://store.nationalwestern.com) or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.

## 2. Special Rules:

- A. Gelbvieh and Balancer cattle will each compete within their respective shows. Group classes can be made up of a combination of Gelbvieh and Balancer cattle, but no group can be entirely made up of Balancers.
- B. All animals exhibited must be recorded in the name of the exhibitor prior to December 15, 2023. A copy of the registration paper or an affidavit of registration must accompany each entry to the show. All cattle will show by the breed percentage rules adopted by the AGA Board of Directors that determines animal category. Animals are placed in the category based on the rule of the year that animal was born: "Percentage, purebred and full blood Gelbvieh females seventy-five (75%) percent to one hundred (100%) percent by category will show together in the Gelbvieh show. Percentage, purebred and full- blood Gelbvieh bulls seventy-five (75%) percent to one hundred (100%) percent by category will show together in the Gelbvieh show. A 75% Gelbvieh female or bull that is 25% Angus or Red Angus can choose whether to show as Gelbvieh or Balancer at the time of entry. No changes can be made after entry deadline. A 75% Gelbvieh female or bull that is 25% other (Hereford, Simmental, etc.) does not have a choice and must show in the Gelbvieh show." To qualify for the Balancer® Show all cattle must meet the American Gelbvieh Association's Balancer trademark rules for registration as a Balancer. Exhibitor must designate Gelbvieh or Balancer as breed on the entry form.
- C. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls twelve (12) months of age or older as of December 31 must be submitted at the time of check-in. Bulls over two (2) years of age must have a semen evaluation certificate issued within 90 days of the show.
- D. Cattle must be entered and under the recorded ownership at the time of the show entry

deadline date. Jointly owned animals must be entered and shown under the multi-ownership (all co-owners) in the individual classes.

- E. All animals must be properly tattooed or EID, including herd prefix, and will be inspected at the show. If the tattoo is illegible or does not correspond to registration certificate, the animal is ineligible to show or may be re-tattooed by the exhibitor and re-checked at the end of processing for a fee of \$50, payable at that time.
- F. All protests against exhibitors, dealing with age or genetic background of show cattle, must be in writing and signed by five (5) active members of the CGA, accompanied by one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars in cash, unless more is required by the show, and then presented to the show Superintendent within twelve (12) hours before starting of the show.
- G. All cattle must meet the health requirements set out by the Show Management. Any deviation from the health requirements will be just cause for immediate disqualification from the show.
- H. Show committee prohibits the use of powders of any color, false tail heads and glued-on hair or hair-like substances.
- I. All bulls must show with a nose lead. Entry into the show ring without one will be an automatic disqualification. The right to disqualify from the show any animal deemed unmanageable is reserved by the show committee.
- J. All females born 09/01/21 - 5/31/22 must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule will apply to a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian or has a natural calf at side.
- K. All females shown in cow/calf class with a calf over one hundred fifty (150) days of age must be bred back and must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of safe in calf will apply to a donor female that has produced fertile eggs in the previous twelve (12) months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.
- L. Age of calf at side in cow/calf class must not exceed 240 days as of date of the show.
- M. Any person found guilty of misrepresentation, or not abiding by the show rules, will be disqualified and denied the privilege of showing.
- N. The most current EPDs will be provided to the judge for consideration and will also be included in the show program. Neither actual or adjusted birth weight, weaning weight or yearling weight will be provided.
- O. Classes will be split as evenly as possible after processing. Splits will be decided using total entries at processing.
- P. National Western will stall all Gelbvieh and Balancer Open Show entries. Direct all requests to National Western on entry form.
- Q. It is expected and required that all parties involved in any Gelbvieh or Balancer show shall respect, cooperate, and be courteous to the judge, show management, exhibitors, the Colorado Gelbvieh Association, AGA staff, and spectators before, during, or after a show. If an exhibitor, employee, or family member of exhibiting operation should violate this via phone call, text message, email, social media, and/or in person, that operation will be removed from the show and/or be banned from exhibiting in any Gelbvieh or Balancer show for a year including AGJA Junior Nationals and the national Gelbvieh and Balancer show. Any Gelbvieh or Balancer animal co-owned by offending operation will also not be allowed to be exhibited at any AGA sanctioned show for that year.

- R. The AGA follows the National Show Ring Code of Ethics. If these codes of ethics are violated, disciplinary action will be taken by the CGA Executive Committee.
- S. Premiums and Awards: First place in each individual animal class and the cow/calf pair classes will receive at least one hundred (\$100) dollars and the remainder of the premiums will be awarded on a graduated scale after the show is completed. The National Western awards ribbons to all winners in each class through tenth (10th) place, rosettes to all Division Champions and Reserves and banners to Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.
- T. Check in for hill cattle will take place throughout the day on Saturday the 6<sup>th</sup>, provide registration and proper ID.

### 1. Entries:

- A. All NWSS livestock entries are online at [livestockentry.nationalwestern.com](http://livestockentry.nationalwestern.com).
- B. Entry Fees: Entry fees are \$55.00 per Pen of Three and \$65.00 per Pen of Five. Yardage fees are \$70.00 per head entered. **Free power and parking are included with entry.**
- C. All Yards and Hill cattle pens/stalls will be pre-bedded for a fee of \$25.00 per head entered. Exhibitors may purchase additional bedding through the NWSS Feed Store online at [store.nationalwestern.com](http://store.nationalwestern.com) or on grounds during the Feed Office hours should they choose to do so.
- D. Registration numbers must be stated on entries.
- E. Entry deadline is November 20, 2023. Late entries are accepted with additional fees until December 20, 2023.

### 2. Special Rules:

- A. Heifers & bulls competing in the Gelbvieh division must be 75% Gelbvieh or greater and registered in the AGA Herd book. All animals must be properly tattooed and or EID matching registration papers and will be inspected at the show.
- B. Heifers & bulls competing in the Balancer division must be registered in the AGA herd book. All animals must be properly tattooed and or EID matching registration papers and will be inspected at the show.
- C. The same Heifers & bulls cannot be entered in a Pen of 3 and Pen of 5. The entries and alternates must be declared by the check-in time and processing time.
- D. This Pen Show is a 'No Fit' Show. NO adhesives, powders or artificial coloring may be used.
- E. The following performance data must be provided to the judge prior to the show for each bull entered: Bull identified by name or number; bull birth date; percent Gelbvieh; and current weight; current scrotal measurement and weight per day of age; and EPD's, for individual and pen. Ultrasound (bulls only, paid by exhibitor) during check in. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls twelve (12) months of age or older as of December 31 must be submitted at the time of check-in. Neither actual nor adjusted birth weight, weaning weight or yearling weight will be provided.
- F. Class will be determined by calculating the average age of the pen. If an alternate is used, age will be recalculated and the pen will be placed in the appropriate class. Young bulls may be shown in an older pen class only if there is a pen class corresponding to his birth date. (IE: an April bull may show in the March class, but a June bull cannot show in any class because there is no June class). Data forms will be provided by the CGA.
- G. Premiums: Colorado Gelbvieh Association offers \$690 of the premiums offered. National Western Stock Show offers \$690. First place in each Gelbvieh and Balancer class will receive at least one hundred (\$100) dollars and the remainder of the premiums will be awarded on a graduated scale after the show is complete. All premiums will be mailed directly from the National Western Stock Show offices.
